

Young Parsee Doctor's Research Recognised

At the American Intraocular Implant and Refractive Society annual meeting in May at San Diego, its **Outstanding Research Presentation award** for the Best paper in LASIK SURGERY was awarded to Dr. KR. Mehta and Dr. Cyres Mehta. The award was presented by Prof. John Marshall from UK, a prominent researcher into LASIK and how it affects the cornea.

very sharp vision was possible after LASIK by targeting distortions on the surface of the cornea with specialized measuring equipment. This research termed **CORBLYOPIA** was well accepted and awarded in USA.

In addition Dr. Cyres', research has been published in the **EUROTIMES**, the most prestigious publication in Eye Surgery read by over 75,000 eye surgeons worldwide.

Dr. Cyres demonstrated a new method of cataract removal through 700 microns and taught a course on it at this meeting to doctors from more than 30 countries.

Usual techniques of Phaco use a 2.8 mm

time in the country the institute uses this **AQUALASE** and **MICROSONIX** burst technology which uses only vibration and warm water pulses which simply wash the cataract away. Naturally there is no chance of damage or heat production or bleeding.

Normally in cataract surgery there is a vibrating metal needle which can touch the other parts of the eye and cause bleeding but **AQUALASE** uses only a soft silicon tip which is completely safe. Patients on blood thinners and high diabetics are especially benefited by this innovation. Dr. Cyres is the **Gold medal** awardee of the Intraocular Implant Society of India for work

He is also the first Indian editor of **EUROTIMES** the European journal of cataract surgeons. Which celebrates its first anniversary in India in July. As well he has delivered over 200 lectures worldwide, edited and written 14 textbooks on cataract and LASIK and is the Indian pioneer of Deep sclerectomy Glaucoma surgery for which he was given the Gold Medal of the International Society of Glaucoma Surgeons in Cairo 2004.
